

## **TRANSPORT TO/FROM WINDHOEK**

SAA and Air Namibia offer reliable, direct flights to/from Windhoek from/to Cape Town and Johannesburg.

Lufthansa and Air Namibia offer direct flights to/from Windhoek from/to Frankfurt.

LTU offers direct flights to/from Windhoek from/to Munich and Düsseldorf.

Air Namibia offers direct flights to/from Windhoek from/to London.

Your travel arrangements are your own responsibility.

Should you travel to Windhoek by road with your own vehicle, parking place will be available at the hotel and conference centre in Windhoek.

## **SHUTTLE SERVICES TO/FROM THE AIRPORT**

Arrangements for your travelling between Windhoek Airport and the Safari Court Hotel and Conference Centre are your own responsibility. The hotel and conference centre are appr. 40 km from Windhoek Airport and appr. 5 km from the city centre.

Shuttle Services from the airport are generally expensive (ranging between N\$ 240 and N\$320). However, bus and taxi services are also available at the Airport. (No train services are available.) The cheapest option would be to take a bus to the city centre, from where you can take a taxi to the Safari hotel (or other accommodation that you have booked). The Safari Court Hotel has a regular Courtesy Shuttle Service to the centre of town, and should you find this shuttle at your arrival in the city centre, you are welcome to make use of this (showing proof of your hotel reservation).

## **DIRECTIONS (WHEN TRAVELLING BY CAR)**

Travelling by car from the Airport (This road is also the road that leads into Windhoek from Botswana, if one comes from Johannesburg by road through Botswana): The road to the city centre should be followed. You will enter the city with Sam Nujoma Road. This road should be followed until you get to Mandume Ndemufayo Road. Turn left in Mandume Ndemufayo and follow this road towards Rehoboth. From the turn-off to Rehoboth with Auas Road you will find Aviation Road and the Safari Complex 500 meters on your right.

From Cape Town the road from Rehoboth should be followed straight into Windhoek. The Safari Complex is on the left just before you reach the city. The complex cannot be missed.
